

Pandemic Policies

It is important that all families understand that Policies must be changed and tightened up to protect other families, children and staff during times of pandemics.

Children will spend their time in the program in small groups with up to 2-3 educators (dependent on Government suggested/mandated occupancy levels at that given time)

Spending a majority of our class time outdoors will also help keep people safe
Food, drinks, dishware and cutlery are not to be shared. Please help to educate your child on the importance of this during such a time.

Cleaning Procedures: before and after each class session, all toys, furniture, walls, floors, carpets (vacuumed) commonly touched places (entry ways, door nobs, handrails, light switches bathrooms ect. will be cleaned/sanitized with approved cleaning solutions.

We ask the following of every family:

1. Do not send your child to daycare sick.
2. Do not administer medication to your child and send him to daycare in hopes we do not notice your child is sick.
3. Have a Plan of Action in place in case you are called that your child is sick.

If your child or you have any of the following please do not come to the Child Care Centre

- Fever, Chills, Cough, Shortness of breath, Sore throat and painful swallowing, Stuffy or Runny Nose, Loss of sense of smell, Headache
- Muscle aches
- Fatigue
- Loss of Appetite.
